

GUIDELINES FOR THE FUN & SAFE USE OF DUKE ENERGY CAMPOREE SITE BOVAY SCOUT RANCH

1. CHARCOAL AND WOOD COOKING FIRES ARE ALLOWED – THIS IS A “LEAVE NO TRACE” AREA – KEEP FIRES SMALL – PLACE ALL ASHES AND CHARCOAL IN BARRELS MARKED FOR SUCH (NO TRASH, FOIL, ECT.) DO NOT LEAVE BURNED OR UNBURNED WOOD ON SITE, REMOVE ALL.
2. WOOD FIRES MAY BE USED FOR CAMPFIRES IF WIND AND WEATHER CONDITIONS PERMIT. NATURAL GAS FIRES WILL BE AVAILABLE IF WIND OR WEATHER CONDITIONS PROHIBIT WOOD FIRES. THIS IS ALSO A “LEAVE NO TRACE” AREA. *NO WOODEN PALLETS WITH NAILS PLEASE.*
3. KEEP ALL VEHICLES ON ROADS AND PARKNG LOTS (*DO NOT DRIVE ON GRASS*)
4. PETS OR ANIMALS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON PROPERTY
5. SKATES, SKATEBOARDS, SCOOTERS ARE NOT TO BE USED ON PROPERTY OR BROUGHT ON PROPERTY.
6. ELECTRICITY IS NOT AVAILABLE IN THIS AREA AND GASOLINE POWERED ELECTRIC GENERATORS MAY BE ALLOWED IN THE EVENT THE DISTRICT COMMITTEE BELIEVES THEIR USE IS NEEDED. THEY MUST GET PRIOR WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THEIR DISTRICT EXECUTIVE AND THE CAMP DIRECTOR. GENERATOR AND FUEL SUPPLY MUST BE UNDER CONTROL OF A RESPONSIBLE ADULT OVER 21 YEARS OF AGE.
7. BICYCLES FOR FAMILY RIDING ARE ALLOWED AT THE DUKE ENERGY CAMPOREE SITE IF THE DISTRICT COMMITTEE AND DISTRICT EXECUTIVE ALLOWS THEM AT THEIR EVENT. BICYCLES ARE TO BE RIDDEN ONLY ON THE ROADS AND ESTABLISHED TRAILS AT BOVAY. PARENTS SHOULD RIDE WITH AND SUPERVISE THEIR YOUTHS BIKE RIDES AT ALL TIMES. ALL RIDERS MUST COMPLY WITH BSA BIKE SAFETY GUIDELINES AND WEAR APPROVED HELMETS. PRIVATE BICYCLES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE BMX TRACK AT ANY TIME. ALL RIDERS SHOULD BE ALERT AND AWARE OF TRAFFIC AND SAFTEY CONSCIOUS AT ALL TIMES
8. PORT-A-POTTIES ARE SET UP BY BOVAY – PLEASE HAVE DISTRICT EXECUTIVE. FILL OUT FORM AND SEND TO BOVAY 90 DAYS BEFORE EVENT WITH A MAP OF WHERE TO PLACE THEM. FEES ARE CHARDED TO DISTRICT ACCOUNT.
9. CAMPERS, POP-UP CAMPERS AND FIFTH WHEEL CAMPERS ARE ALLOWED ONLY IN DEDICATED AREA DESCRIBED BY DISTRICT COMMITTEE. THERE ARE NO ELECTRIC HOOKUPS OR SEWER DUMPS AT BOVAY.
10. GOLF CARTS, JD GATORS, AND KAWASAKI MULES ARE ALLOWED ONLY DURING DISTRICT EVENTS WHERE IT IS DETERMINED THAT THEY ARE NECESSARY TO ASSIST IN THE SETUP AND OPERATION OF A DISTRICT EVENT. ALL DRIVER/OPERATORS MUST BE RESPONSIBLE ADULTS AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD. NO PERSON WILL RIDE IN THE BACK BED AREA. THE DISTRICT SAFETY COMMITTEE IS EXPECTED TO DETERMINE WITH THE DISTRICT EXECUTIVE THE NUMBER OF THESE ALLOWED. OWNER MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF LIBALITY INSURANCE COVERAGE ON VEHICLE. See special rule sheet.
11. ALL TRASH IS TO BE TAKEN TO DUMPSTERS BY WATER WELL ON EXIT ROAD.
12. ALL PERSONAL AND DISTRICT EQUIPMENT NEEDS TO BE REMOVED WHEN EVENT IS OVER
13. DISTRICT SAFETY COMMITTEE NEEDS TO MAKE SURE UNITS ADHERE TO ALL SITE RULES
14. ROSTERS OF ALL PARTICITANTS ARE TURNED INTO RANGER WITHIN 12 HOURS OF ARRIVAL.
15. ALL INJURIES ARE REPORTED TO RANGER BEFORE LEAVING

16. CAMP DIRECTOR OR RANGER WILL CALL IN ALL EMERGENCIES –PROCEDURIES ARE ALREADY IN PLACE WITH AGENCIES TO HANDLE EMERGENCY EVENTS. RANGER CAN BE REACHED AT 936-520-3932 OR CAMP DIRECTOR AT 713-822-3793.
17. RESERVATIONS FOR THIS AREA ARE MADE THROUGH YOUR DISTRICT EXECUTIVE DIRECTLY TO CAMPING SERVICES.
